As part of the construction of the new Patient Care Tower at Royal Inland Hospital, flooring selections had to meet high standards of performance, safety, durability, and hygiene. Designed to LEED Gold standards, the new building required materials that would help create a healthy, welcoming environment for patients, staff, and visitors.

The architectural concept, titled "Connection: Where the Waters Meet," draws inspiration from the culture of the Tk'emlúps te Secwépemc people and the natural surroundings of the region. The visual identity of the project incorporates cultural motifs, natural textures, and a colour palette reflecting the local environment.

Mipolam Affinity & Elegance

20,000 yd²: used in care areas and corridors for their durability, ease of maintenance, and antibacterial properties.

Taralay Impression 3,000 yd²:

installed in public areas to add visual appeal and create clear wayfinding cues.

Tarasafe 2,000 yd²: used in high-risk areas (entrances, stairs, locker rooms) for its slip resistance and safety performance.
